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## East Amwell Township Historic Preservation Committee Second "Annual Preservation & Design Award"

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The East Amwell Historic Preservation Committee is proud to continue the Preservation & Design Awards as an annual program for property owners, residents and businesses of East Amwell.

This program is intended to increase awareness of the built environment and landscapes of our historic community. The awards are intended to encourage quality restoration, construction, design and landscaping, and to acknowledge the hard work and effort that property owners

and businesses - including farms - have put in to their homes, buildings, farms and landscaping.

All are invited to submit applications for projects that relate to the five categories listed below. Additionally, a resident may nominate a project other than their own. Multiple entries are permitted. A written description of the project and photographs clearly showing the project or work should be submitted by the deadline of July 30, 2010. See specific

details on the submission form.

Award recipients will be selected by independent judges invited by the HPC. Projects selected to receive awards will be notified in October, 2010. May is officially Historic Preservation Month in the United States. Those projects chosen for awards will receive a bronze plaque at a presentation ceremony date to be announced.

Multiple awards may be presented in each category.

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### CATEGORIES:

• **HISTORIC RESIDENTIAL:**

Projects that relate to rehabilitation or restoration of any existing residence built prior to 1900. May be interior or exterior projects.

• **NEWER RESIDENTIAL:**

Projects of post 1900 or new builds that complement the historical nature of our community. May be interior or exterior projects.

• **GARDENS & LANDSCAPING:**

Projects involving landscaping or exterior gardening - specifically focusing on plan, design and relationship to the existing landscape. Structures may be included, but are not the main elements to be considered.

• **COMMERCIAL PROJECTS:**

Construction of new buildings or re-design of existing buildings that suggest historic Amwell Valley.

• **FARMSTEADS OR FARM BUILDINGS:**

Preservation, rehabilitation or new construction of farmsteads or farm accessory buildings.

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All projects must be located in East Amwell Township.

Judges may request a tour of the project.

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
