

What to do if you see a Spotted Lantern Fly (SLF) on your property or anywhere else:

- Kill it.
- Take a picture: With your GPS function turned on your smartphone or a camera with GPS, take a photograph of ANY life stage (including egg masses). The photograph can be submitted to SLF-plantindustry@ag.nj.gov.
- Report a site: If you can't take a specimen or photograph, call New Jersey Spotted Lanternfly Hotline at 1-833-223- 2840 (BADBUG0) and leave a message detailing your sighting and contact information.

As a reminder, East Amwell Township is in a quarantine zone, so no moving firewood, construction materials, plants, etc.without following the very strict [NJ Dept of Ag guidelines](#).
