

Hello East Amwell Community we are writing from the East Amwell Environmental Club and we hope you can help us out. This year the East Amwell Environmental Club and East Amwell School have been collecting all kinds of trash and we want to collect some of yours too! We have been collecting for a company named Terra Cycle. Terra Cycle collects these items to recycle them instead of these items going to a landfill and pays the non-profit organization or school for those items. Some of these items to collect are all types of drink pouches (such as Capri Sun), all cookie wrappers (such as OREO), all types of chip, popcorn, and pretzel bags, and Ziploc or Glad plastic zippered baggies. Each item is worth 2 cents a piece! With the money raised our club has been able to buy plants for our school gardens, help attract native butterflies, feed birds throughout the winter, and buy birdhouses so they have a place in Spring to raise their young. We hope you can help us continue collecting these items to save precious landfill space and provide plants for wildlife by recycling the “trash” we suggest.
