Site Visit	Davis, William		7/1/04		<p>On 7/1/04 I arrived at Lindbergh Rd to look for solid waste as described in this incident report. In spite of the detailed directions and maps provided by Michael McCann of NJDEP Greenacres program it was very difficult to find the area in question. I managed to find it because of the red flag Mike had tied around a tree. The area exists off of the road, there is no clear path now that summer vegetation has overgrown the area.</p> <p>The area itself was pleasant. Trees, vines, and flowers grew, deer were observed along with several bird species.</p> <p>A relatively small amount of solid waste was observed. This included plastic sheets, corrugated plastic, a very rusted refrigerator without a door, a very rusted washing machine, an old wheelbarrow, a very rusted metal tank, and two piles of old rimless tires. Altogether there seems to be less than thirty cubic yards of debris here, this being scattered across a fairly wide area, perhaps a quarter acre.</p>	Solid Waste - Central	BPETITT	3/2/05 17:45
